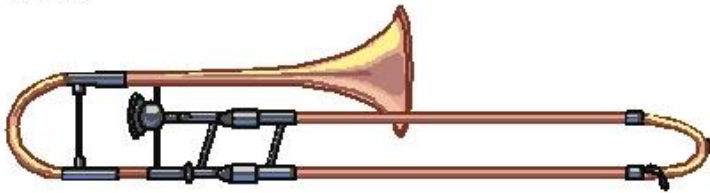

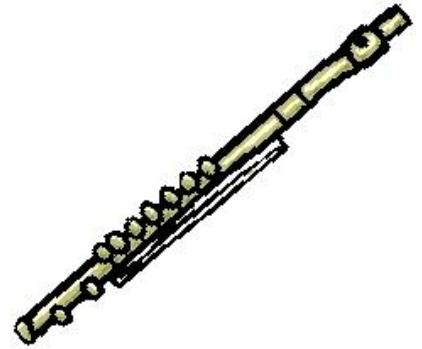

MUSIC INSTRUMENT POSTER/CARDS INSTRUCTIONS

1. PRINT ONE MUSIC INSTRUMENTS POSTER
2. PRINT 2 OR MORE OF EACH OF MUSIC INSTRUMENTS POSTER/CARDS¹ AND MUSIC INSTRUMENTS POSTER².
3. PRINT MUSIC INSTRUMENT NAMES AND CUT INTO INDIVIDUAL STRIPS.

POSSIBLE GAMES ARE:

ONE POSTER AND ONE SET OF CARDS:

1. MATCH THE CARDS TO THE INSTRUMENTS ON THE POSTER. THIS CAN BE DONE BY AN INDIVIDUAL CHILD OR CAN BE DONE AS A GROUP WHERE EACH CHILD DRAWS A CARD AND THEN MATCHES IT TO THE POSTER.
2. HIDE SET OF CARDS. LET CHILDREN FIND AND MATCH TO THE POSTER.
3. HAND OUT CARDS. LISTEN TO THE INSTRUMENT AUDIO SOUNDS AND LET CHILDREN SEE IF THEY CAN PRESENT THE CORRECT CARD WHEN THE AUDIO OF EACH INSTRUMENT IS PLAYED.

TWO SETS OF CARDS:

1. MATCH CARDS.
2. PLAY A CONCENTRATION GAME. YOU MAY NEED TO GLUE A BACK TO THESE SO CHILDREN CAN'T SEE THROUGH THE CARD.
3. PLAY "GO FISH".
4. LET CHILDREN MATCH THE MUSICIAN CARDS TO A SIMILAR, BUT NOT EXACT, CARD OF THE SAME INSTRUMENT.

THREE SETS OF CARDS

1. PLAY A HARDER VERSION OF CONCENTRATION. YOU MAY NEED TO GLUE A BACK TO THESE SO CHILDREN CAN'T SEE THROUGH THE CARD.

INSTRUMENT NAME STRIPS, CARDS, AND POSTERS

1. MATCH THE MUSIC INSTRUMENT NAMES TO THE PRINTED NAMES ON THE MUSIC INSTRUMENTS POSTER.
2. MATCH THE MUSIC INSTRUMENT NAMES TO POSTERS OR CARDS THAT DO NOT HAVE PRINTED NAMES ON THEM. (For children who can read, or who have learned the names after playing the game for a while)
