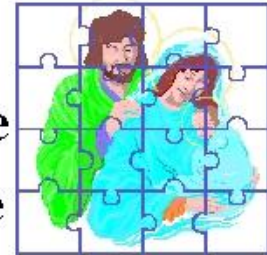

How to tell about Jesus Instruction sheet

One set of cards (23 cards & one name card) For younger children, reduce the number of cards (and strips, if using those). Choose the easiest cards for them.

23 strips

6 ways to play

1. Pass out cards and ask who has the picture of someone who is (raking someone's leaves). Can he/she also tell that person (whose leaves are being raked) about Jesus?
2. Make a collage'. Talk about the pictures on the collage'.
3. Enlarge the pictures in the cards. Put them in a floor pocket game mat. Let child toss a bean bag and tell about the picture. Can then take the pictures and put them up on bulletin board to discuss or can make a large collage'.
4. Let child choose a card and tell how he can show and tell others about Jesus' love.
5. Put strips in a small bucket or other container. Children pick a strip & then find matching picture and tells what is on the card.
6. I've Got a Secret-Teacher picks a card, says "I've got a secret and I am going to let you guess what it is." Take a card from the deck of cards and gradually describe the picture allowing children to guess what the teacher is describing as a way to tell others.
EXAMPLE: "I have a friend who doesn't know that Jesus loves her. I am going to tell my friend about Jesus. I getting a piece of paper and a pencil. (wait for children to guess what you are going to do). I am getting an envelope and a stamp. (wait for children to guess). I am writing. (guess). Answer, of course, is the card -Write a letter.

Two sets of cards

Multiple ways to play

1. Individual or group matching game
2. Concentration game
3. Treasure hunt-give child a card that he is to find the matching card. If you are industrious, you may give him clues or a map to follow. Can do this as a class and move from one treasure spot to another by clues or by map.
4. Innumerable other ways. See what you can think of & share it with me.

Hear & Do

Let children do one or more of the activities found in the pictures. EXAMPLE: Let them make a picture of Jesus or write the word Jesus in large letters. Then cut the picture or letters into puzzle pieces. Put the pieces in an envelope. Get them to tell you a specific person that they will give the puzzle to. Ask them to tell that person that Jesus loves them as they give them the puzzle.
