## CHILDREN OF THE WORLD PAPER DOLLS WITH HOUSES










AFRICAN people live in many different parts of a very big continent. Some Africans live in jungles where there are

many wild animals and birds. Jesus wants them to know Him, too.











Cut slot along dotted lines on shield. Cut out and slip the strip above through the slots. This will form a handle on the back of the shield so that Nukaru can hold it.



Nukaru is a boy who lives far away in Africa.




Nukaru's father made this necklace for him.






The AMERICAN INDIANS live on reservations in many different places in the United States. Many of the Indian people don't know Jesus and his love for them.



Arturo and all his friends wear "delantales" to school. They are white smocks that button down the front for the boys and in the back for girls.







"Puchero" is Arturo's favorite stew.




Arturo's home is made of handmade bricks, covered with plaster. Cut out and stand on its place on the map.




No part of BOLIVIA is on an ocean. Sometimes it's called "The Land in the Sky" because of its high mountains. Many

people live in these mountains. There are thousands of boys and girls who don't know Jesus.




PETA (PAY-tah) lives high in the mountains of BOLIVIA.

Peta lives in a small house made of adobe (a-DOE-be), which is large blocks of clay and straw. *Cut out and stand on its place on the map*.




BRAZIL is the largest country in South America. It has a long coastline on the Atlantic Ocean. It has big cities very much

like ours, but there also are people living deep in the jungle lands. BRAZIL has many people who don't know Jesus.




Maria picks coffee berries which are bright red when they are ripe.




Maria often takes care of baby brother "Manoel" by carrying him around like this.

Maria's sturdy house is made of brick with concrete over it. It is light yellow with red tile roof. *Cut out and stand on its place on the map.* 






Make little round holes in runners of sled. Tie string in holes and put into Amak's hand or around dog.


An Indian necklace and bracelet.



This is Indira who lives in India. We would have to travel a long way to visit her.




Indira lights a little lamp.

> This is one of Mitsuki's dresses called a kimono. The colorful sash is called an "obi."






Mitsuki is a Japanese girl who loves to dress up in her beautiful Japanese costumes.


Sometimes Mitsuki carries a colorful paper fan in her hand.




MEXICO is our next-door neighbor. It is right across the Rio Grande River. It is a warm country with no winters, although


snow stays on the high mountains all y ar. Many of our Mexic n neighbors would like to know more about Jesus.




Conchita can carry a big load on her head. She balances it perfectly and it makes her walk nice and straight.



CONCHITA lives with her father and mother and six brothers and sisters.











Conchita's house was built only a few years ago. It is white stucco and has a nice garden in the back. *Cut out and stand on its place on the map*.



NICARAGUA is a little country in Central America. Twenty-three volcanoes there have made the soil good would like us to tell the people in


for growing things. Jesus would like us to tell the people in NICARAGUA about Him.








PERU is a country of dry deserts, high mountains and hot steamy jungles. Some parts haven't been

explored yet. Everywhere in PERU are people who need to know Jesus.


